5 19-06-2019 This application has been filed for initiation of contempt proceeding for violation of order dated 01.11.2017 passed by a Bench by Division Bench of this Court in Criminal Writ Jurisdiction Case No. 2032 of 2017, by which, the respondents were directed to consider the case of the petitioner for



his release, in accordance with law and if the petitioner's claim is not found tenable then a reasoned order would be required to be passed and a copy of the same should be supplied to the petitioner and the petitioner would be at liberty to assail the same before the competent court.

A show cause has been filed by the State showing that his claim was considered and the same was dismissed by a reasoned order.

In such view of the matter, petitioner has sought permission for withdrawal of the present application to move before the appropriate forum to raise his grievances.
