ORAL ORDER

2 26-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition Excise Act.

Informant who is police officer has alleged in his written report that on information police raided near Gami Pokhra and with the help of sniffer dog squad recovered 482 bottles of 180 ml. each total 86.76 liters foreign wine from the west bank of Gami Pokhar.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he is innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case only on the basis of suspicion.



Petitioner was not apprehended on the spot. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 16.10.2019.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-special Judge (Excise) Darbhanga, in connection with G.O. Case No. 1048 of 2019/Laheriasarai P.S. Case No. 430 of 2019, subject to conditions:

- (1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.
- (3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
- (4) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offences, after his release on bail the trial court shall take steps to cancel his bail bonds.
