2 03-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Shikarpur P.S. Case No. 37 of 2019, registered for offence punishable under Section 366 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Further submission is that from perusal of FIR as well as statement recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C., it appears that there are two different stories in the FIR and the statement recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. The petitioner is in custody since 03.09.2019.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the



above-named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Sikarpur P.S. Case No. 371 of 2019.
