ORAL ORDER

2 18-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 25(1-B)A,
26 of the Arms Act.

Allegation is recovery of one loaded pistol and four
live cartridges from the possession of petitioner.

Considering the nature of allegation against petitioner, I
am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly the
prayer for bail is rejected at this stage.

However, after six months of custody the petitioner would
be enlarged on bail by the court below itself on furnishing bail
bond of Rs. 20,000/- (twenty thousand) with two sureties of the
like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below, in



connection with Bihar P.S. Case No. 452 of 2019 subject to the conditions that:-

(1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.

(2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and his absence on two consecutive dates without proper and sufficient reason the trial court will be at liberty to cancel his bail bond.

(3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
