2 25-06-2019 This writ petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for release of vehicle Mahindra Bolero Pickup bearing Registration No.BR06C-5808, which has been seized in connection with N. H. Bangara P. S. Case No. 04 of 2018 registered under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a), 38(1) and 38(2) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Realizing that the confiscation is a civil proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the
