2 20-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection
with Singheshwar P.S. Case No. 182 of 2019 for the offence
registered under Sections 143, 342, 323, 332, 353 and 504 of
the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only
because he is stated to be a part of the crowd, the petitioner is
apprehending his arrest. The petitioner is a practicing doctor
and has nothing to do with the alleged occurrence.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of
the case and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let
the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender



before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madhepura in connection with Singheswar P.S. Case No. 182 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
