ORAL ORDER

4 18-12-2019 Instant petition under Sections 439 and 440 of Criminal Procedure Code has been moved for grant of bail in F.I.R. No. 137 of 2019 dated 08.08.2019 registered at Police Station Amdabad under Sections 302, 201 and 354(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of POCSO Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State. I have also perused the relevant record of the case, necessary for adjudication of this petition.

At this stage, considering the nature of the offence, the Court is not inclined to grant bail. The trial is in progress and the offence is serious.

At this stage, learned counsel submits that petitioner shall be content if he is permitted to withdraw the instant



petition reserving liberty to file a fresh application after a period of six months.

Permission granted.

The petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.
