2 10-04-2019 This application under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for directing and commanding the respondent authorities to release the vehicle (Motorcycle Splendor Hero I Smart) bearing Registration No. BHR-52B-5499 (Permanent Reg. No. BR-52-B-7174) which has illegally been seized in connection with Sheikhpura P.S. Case No.507of 2018 registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Realizing that the confiscation is a civil proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a civil



writ application for the release of vehicle (Motorcycle Splendor
