counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with
Anti P.S. Case No. 58 of 2019 for the offence under sections
341, 323, 379, 504, 354, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned counsel submits that petitioner is a student
aged about 19 years. He submits that due to village politics he
has been roped in the instant case.

Learned counsel submits that if the petitioner is not
granted privilege of bail, his career will be ruined.

Considering the age of the petitioner and the fact that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent, the court is inclined to



grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, VIIIth, Gaya and his successor court, in connection with Anti P.S. Case No. 58 of 2019 subject to the condition as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
