3 09-01-2019 Heard both sides.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in Jalalgarh P.S. Case No.7 of 2018 registered under Sections 379 and 413 of the Indian Penal Code, under Section 40 of the Bihar Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1972 and Section 15 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

The gist of the allegation is that the petitioner was running a brick kiln without paying the tax amounting to Rs.74,000/- and odd and also without obtaining environment clearance certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the District Mining Officer, Purnea issued letter no.897 on 19.09.2018 after receiving Rs.74,500/-. The petitioner did not evade payment of any tax.



Considering the facts aforesaid and nature of allegation made against the petitioner, let petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of this order be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Purnea in connection with Jalalgarh P.S. Case No.7 of 2018, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
