2 04-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of
Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

From a four wheeler huge quantity of liquor was
recovered on 19.10.2019 and two persons were apprehended.
The said vehicle was registered in the name of the petitioners.

Submission is that the petitioner had already leased
out the said vehicle to co-accused Ganesh Sao who was
apprehended. The lease was prior to the alleged date of
recovery.

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his
arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of



thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/-(Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Excise Case No.682/2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
