Nobody appears on behalf of the petitioner. Learned APP for the State has assisted the Court.

On 01.04.2019, the Court had recorded that learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that he had already undergone the period of sentence of six months in custody and, thereafter, has been released from prison but he wanted to challenge the judgment of conviction and for that purpose, the matter was admitted and the Lower Courts Record were called.
