2 05-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Kinjar P.S. Case No.17 of 2019 (Excise Case No.184/2019) registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(A) of the Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries from the motorcycle were not to the knowledge of the petitioners and the said seizure has not been made in their presence and thus nothing has been recovered from their conscious possession. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that these petitioner have got no



criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-II, Jehanabad, in connection with Kinjar P.S. Case No.17 of 2019 (Excise Case No.184/2019), subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
