3 31-01-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 194 of 2018, disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 379, 354(B), 307, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of assault to the informant causing injury to him.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that there is case and counter case between the parties and injuries are simple in nature. Further, he has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. as well as learned counsel for the informant.

Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above



named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur, in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 194 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
