2 18-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal
Code and 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The written report of the informant reflects that 15 to
20 persons managed to escape leaving behind illicit liquor.
Petitioner and two others were caught on the spot but there is
nothing in the written report to show that any recovery was
made from conscious possession of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as
well as submissions of the parties and also taking note of this
fact that petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent, let the



petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge 2nd Madhubani in connection with Basopatti P.S. Case No. 241 of 2018.
