ORAL ORDER

10 27-11-2019 This is an application for bail on behalf of the above named petitioner who has been made accused in connection with Barauni (Refinery) P.S. Case No.209 of 2011 dated 25.8.2011 for the alleged offence under Sections-147, 148, 149, 323, 307, 302 and 337 of I.P.C. and 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned A.P.P. states that prosecution witnesses have been examined and insofar as trial is concerned, the stage is that of recording the statement of the accused.

Learned counsel for the complainant, against whom cross-case also stands registered and trial is in progress,



states that his clients would fully cooperate during trial and not take any unnecessary adjournment.

Statement accepted and taken on record.

If the Court were to find such statement to have been flouted in any manner, it would be open for the Court to not only take appropriate action in accordance with law, but also examine the possibility of cancelling the privilege of bail granted to the said accused.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present application.

The application is dismissed as not pressed.
