2 04-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking bail in Kutumba P.S. Case No.141 of 2019 registered for offence punishable under Section 30 (a) of Bihar Excise (Prohibition) Amendment Act.

As per allegation, 79.2 liters of country made liquor were recovered from a Tempo. The petitioners were arrested while fleeing away from the Tempo. However, it is submitted that petitioners are in custody since 30.09.2019. It is claimed that their antecedents are clean.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,



the petitioners, above-named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Aurangabad in connection with Kutumba P.S. Case No. 141/2019 with a condition that if the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
