ORAL ORDER

4 18-12-2019 Instant petition under Section 438 of Criminal Procedure Code has been moved for grant of anticipatory bail in F.I.R. No. 134 of 2019 dated 15.07.2019 registered at Police Station Kumarkhand under Sections 25(1-B)a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State. I have also perused the relevant record of the case, necessary for adjudication of this petition.

At this stage, considering the nature of the offence, the Court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail. The investigation is in progress and the offence is serious.

At this stage, learned counsel submits that petitioner shall be content if he is permitted to withdraw the instant



petition reserving liberty to file a fresh application after a period of six months.

Permission granted.

The petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.
