2 16-04-2019 This application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for a direction to the respondents to release Tempo (three wheeler) bearing registration No. BR43P-5608, Chassis No. MD2A95AY9HWH44745 and Engine No. BBYWHH44745, which has been seized in connection with Araria P.S. Case No. 639 of 2018 registered under Sections 30(a), 36 and 38 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Realizing the confiscation is a civil proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioner sought leave to withdraw the
