The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Mufassil P.S.
Case No.299 of 2019, registered under Sections 341, 323, 498A,
504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is the husband of the informant and the petitioner is
ready to keep his wife and child.

Learned counsel for the informant as well as learned
Additional Public Prosecutor submit that the petitioner has
already solemnized second marriage and the petitioner got one
child from his second wife. The informant submits that she has
got every apprehension of being killed at the hands of the
petitioner. The petitioner has not been keeping her since last 11
years.



It appears that the petitioner, firstly, deserted his wife, the informant, immediately after she gave birth to a male child and remained missing but during that period, he solemnized second marriage and the petitioner also got a son from his second wife. Now the petitioner pretends to keep his first wife with all honour and dignity but the informant submits that it is not feasible for her to live with her husband.

Taking into consideration the facts aforesaid, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected.
