2 24-06-2019 This application under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for directing the respondent authorities to release of the Motorcycle (Pulsar 220 SF) bearing registration no.BR-01CQ-4964 which has illegally been seized in connection with Patrakar Nagar P.S. Case No.349 of 2018 arising out of Special Case No.6167 of 2018 registered under Sections 33(a)(b), 38 and 41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Realizing that the confiscation is a civil proceeding,
learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the



present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a civil writ application for release of the Motorcycle (Pulsar 220 SF) bearing registration no.BR-01CQ-4964 seized in connection with Patrakar Nagar P.S. Case No.349 of 2018 arising out of Special Case No.6167 of 2018.
