counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The grievance of the petitioner is against the non-communication of the order, which has rendered the petitioner helpless in filing the appeal before the Commissioner within the time.

Considering the fact that the order rejecting the application for grant of licence was not communicated, the Court disposes of the writ petition with the liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal before the Commissioner, Magadh Division, Gaya.
