2 08-04-2019 This application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for directing and commanding the respondent authorities to release the Tempo bearing Registration No. BR-26K-0939 which has illegally been seized in connection with Goh P.S. Case No.109 of 2018 under Sections 30(a), 38 and 47 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Realizing that the confiscation is a civil proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a civil writ application for the release of Tempo bearing Registration No. BR-26K-0939 seized in connection with Goh
