Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Bikram P.S. Case No. 110/2019 registered for the offense punishable under Sections 379/420/467/468 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 26(a)/27/21(a)/22/04/40 of Bihar Minor Minerals Concession Rules, 1972.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the alleged occurrence, the petitioner has already been fined and has deposited Rs.80,000/- (Eighty thousand) through a demand draft dated 08.04.2019 with the Department. However, the authorities are behaving in a totally highhanded manner and have now filed a case under Section 279/420/467/468 of the IPC only to harass and humiliate the petitioner. Learned counsel for



the petitioner submits that since the fine has already been deposited and that the petitioner bears no criminal antecedent, the petitioner be extended the benefit of pre-arrest bail.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, VI, Danapur, Patna, in connection with Bikram P.S. Case No. 110/2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
