Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner has been in custody since 26.10.2019 in
connection with Amarpur (Fulli Dumar) P.S. Case No. 135 /
2019 registered for the offence punishable under Sections
304(B)/201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that so far
as the present petitioner is concerned, she is the sister-in-law
(*Gotni*) of the deceased lady and has no role in the affairs of the
family and that she is also similarly placed daughter-in-law. It is
further submitted that except suspicion, there is no other
material against the present petitioner.

Considering the aforementioned facts and
circumstances, let the petitioner above named be released on



bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka, in connection with Amarpur (Fulli Dumar) P.S. Case No. 135/2019.
