2 12-12-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Dighalbank P.S. Case No. 93 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 341, 342, 323, 504, 324, 307, 379, 120-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(i)(r) (s) of SC/ST Act.

Allegation against the appellant is of abusing the informant by caste name and also of assaulting him.

Submission of learned counsel for the appellant is that he has falsely been implicated in this case and no specific allegation has been attributed to the appellant.

Learned Special P.P. opposed the prayer for pre arrest bail and submitted that there are allegation against the appellant of abusing the informant by caste name and also of assaulting him and as such, a prima facie case is made out



against the appellant.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of pre arrest bail to the appellant rather appellant has to surrender before the court below and make prayer for regular bail and if any such application is filed, the court below will dispose of the same on the merit of the case, without being prejudiced by this order.

This appeal is, accordingly, dismissed.
