ORAL ORDER

2 19-12-2019 Instant petition under Sections 439 and 440 of Criminal Procedure Code has been moved for grant of bail in F.I.R. No. 53 of 2019, dated 25.5.2019, registered at Police Station Araria Mahila, under Sections 376/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 4 of the POCSO Act, pending in the court of learned 1st Addl. Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Araria.
