3 17-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned
counsel for the State and learned counsel for the BSSC.

Vide order dated 28.08.2018 passed in CWJC No.
11741 of 2018, this Court directed the Authority concerned to
consider the case of the petitioners and take decision in
accordance with law and, accordingly, decision has been taken
by the Authority concerned and the claim of the petitioners has
been rejected.
