3 03-09-2019 This application under Articles 226 and 227 of the

Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for
directing and commanding the respondent authorities to release
the Tata Ace vehicle bearing Registration No. WB-19J-4106,
which has illegally been seized in connection with Cheria
Bariyarpur P.S. Case No.112 of 2018 registered under Section
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Realizing that the confiscation is a civil
proceeding, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to
withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner
to file a civil writ application for the release of Tata Ace vehicle



bearing Registration No.WB-19J-4106 seized in connection
with Cheria Bariyarpur P.S. Case No. 112 of 2018.

Leave is granted.
