ORAL ORDER

2 18-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Mojahidpur (Babarganj) P.S. Case No.298 of 2019, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 307, 420, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the co-accused including the petitioner is to have assaulted the victim with lathi and danda, however, counsel for the petitioner submits that the injury has been found to be simple in nature. The petitioner is a lady.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on



furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Mojahidpur (Babarganj) P.S. Case No. 298 of 2019 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
