2 18-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Begusarai Mahila P.S. Case No.15 of
2016, registered for the offence under Section 498A and 323 of
the Indian Penal Code and under Section 3/4 of the Dowry
Prohibition Act.

Considering the fact that the petitioners are other than
the husband of the informant, let the petitioners, above-named,
be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or
surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six



weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-
(Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate,
Begusarai, in connection with Begusarai Mahila P.S. Case no.
15 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section
438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
