The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in  
connection with Udakishunganj P.S. Case No.176 of 2019  
registered for the offence punishable under Section 392 of the  
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. but subsequently, during the  
course of investigation on the basis of the confessional  
statement made before the police by one Sandeep Sah alias  
Chunmun Sah, he is now facing prosecution. It is further  
submitted that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforementioned facts and



circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Udakishunganj, District-Madhepura, in connection with Udakishunganj P.S. Case No.176 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
