2 20-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Rupauli P.S. Case No. 11 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 448/341/323/427/504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is land dispute between the parties and the present false case has been filed stating that the petitioners entered into their house and mutilated the properties. It is further submitted that there is no eye-witness to the occurrence and for that matter nor is there any impartial witness.



Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the petitioners are not having any criminal antecedents, let the petitioners above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purnea, in connection with Rupauli P.S. Case No. 11 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
