The present application has been preferred by the petitioner nos.1 and 2 in the application under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure *inter alia* praying for relaxation of the conditions of anticipatory bail, as incorporated in the order dated 18th September, 2019 passed in CRM No.8353 of 2019.
