Mr. Bhattacharya, learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that due to the pandemics the petitioners could not appear before the learned Court below within the period as directed by the order passed on 2nd December, 2019.

After the pandemic situation normalised, the petitioners filed the present application in the month of December, 2021 praying for extension of time to appear before the learned Court below and to pray for regular bail.
