It is submitted by the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner that she is a lady and executed the power of attorney in favour of the co-accused Prodig Kumar Mondal to ply the vehicle in question.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that the vehicle was used for transportation of narcotic substance which is above commercial quantity.

We have considered the materials on record. We note the said Prodig Kumar Mondal is an accused in the present case. Involvement

of the petitioner as a conspirator in the crime cannot be wholly ruled out.

In view of the gravity of the offence and her prima facie involvement in the alleged crime, we are of the opinion that this is not a fit case to grant anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.
