The present appellant has previously preferred an appeal (Criminal Appeal No.3171/1999) from jail in the same Sessions Trial No.198/1998 against the same judgment impugned dated 06.05.1999 convicting him under Sections 363/34 and 366/34 IPC and sentencing him to undergo RI for 5 years with fine of Rs.2000 on each count.
