Hon'ble Shri Justice P. Sam Koshy**Order on Board****25/01/2019**

1. The challenge in the present writ petition to the order of punishment dated 14/08/17 (Annexure P-5) and the rejection of the departmental appeal (Annexure P-2) dated 16/03/18.
2. The perusal of the record shows that the appeal has been decided by the D.I.G, C.R.P.F. and against the said order of rejection of appeal,

the petitioner has a statutory remedy of revision before the I.G., C.R.P.F. under Rule 29 of the C.R.P.F. Rules, 1955.

3. It appears that the petitioner has not availed the second remedy of appeal against the order passed in the first appeal.
4. Given the said facts, as there is a statutory alternative remedy available to the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to entertain this writ petition at this juncture. Reserving the right of the petitioner to prefer a revision before the I.G. under Rule 29, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
5. In the event if the petitioner prefers a revision before the authority concerned within a period of 3 weeks from today, the revisional authority ignoring the aspect of limitation considering the gravity of the punishment imposed, shall consider the revision petition on its merits.
6. With the aforesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
