1. This is the first bail application under Section 439 of the CrPC and there is no bail application is pending before any other Court.
2. The applicant has been arrested in connection with Crime No.72/2019 registered at Police Station- Excise Circle Tilda, Civil and Revenue District- Raipur (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Sections 34(1), A, B, 34 (2), 59(A) of CG Excise Act.
3. Argument heard.
4. Case of the prosecution, in brief is that on 30.01.2019, 5.76 bulk liters country made liquor has been seized from the possession of the applicant.
5. Counsel for the State submits that three other criminal cases have been registered against the applicant out of which one under Excise Act, two under CrPC.
6. Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, the application is allowed. It is directed that if the applicant furnishes two solvent sureties for a sum of Rs. 25,000/- along with a personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court with condition that he will not involve in any crime in future, he will appear before the trial Court at 11:00 am as and when directed till trial and he would cooperate during the trial, he shall be released on bail.
