1. The grievance of the petitioners is non counting of their past service rendered prior to joining of present employment.
2. The contention of the petitioners is that the matter stands covered by the decision of this court rendered in WPS No.2530 of 2017 (Mukesh Kumar Patel and another Vs. State of Chhattisgarh and another) as also the batch of writ petitions disposed of by this Court on 27.10.2018, the lead case of which being WPS No.6147 of 2018 (Shabnum Khatun Vs. State of Chhattisgarh & Ors.) and other analogous petitions.
3. The counsel appearing for the State submits that probably the petitioners as of now do not have minimum required length of service for grant of benefit that they have claimed for which otherwise has not been disputed by the counsel for the petitioner.
4. Given the facts, the writ petition stands disposed of with an

observation that the petitioners on their completing the required length of service of 8 years shall approach the authorities in the department for the relief sought for and the authorities shall consider the same in the light of the decision rendered by this Court in the case of similarly placed persons and shall pass an appropriate order.

5. With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition stands disposed of.
