1. The limited relief which the petitioner has sought through the present writ petition is for a direction to the respondent No. 1 to decide the representation which the petitioner has made so far as grant of study leave is concerned.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while the petitioner was pursuing Post Graduate Course for M.S./M.D. in Ayurveda, she got selected as Medical Officer, Ayurveda under the respondents and got appointment order in her favour and has also joined her duties. According to the petitioner, in order to pursue her studies and to complete the course, she has applied for study leave and the application is pending consideration before the authorities concerned and the petitioner wants that the authority may decide her claim at the earliest.

3. To the said limited prayer, State counsel does not have any objection.
4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondent No. 1 to decide the representation of the petitioner for grant of study leave at the earliest within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this writ petition.
5. It is made clear that this court has not expressed any observations on the merits of the case so far as the claim put forth by the petitioner is concerned. The authorities shall take a decision in accordance with rules governing the field.
