1. This writ petition has been brought under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that a direction be issued to respondents No.1 to 3 to register FIR on the complaint filed by the petitioner.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has filed an application under Section 156(3) of the Cr.P.C. before the learned Court of Magistrate having jurisdiction in which the order has not been passed, therefore, this matter be disposed off with an appropriate direction.
