By the impugned order dated 7.3.2019, petitioner's application under Section 79(A) of the Information Technology Act, 2000 read with Section 45 of the Evidence Act for opinion of expert of C.D. has been rejected by the Family Court, Bemetara, against which instant writ petition has been preferred.
 2. I have heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and perused the impugned order with utmost circumspection.
