1. This is the first bail application under Section 439 of the CrPC and there is no bail application is pending before any other Court.
2. The applicant has been arrested in connection with Crime No.212/2019 registered in Police Station Excise Sub Inspector, Circle Dhamdha, District Durg (C.G.) for the offence punishable under Section 34(2) of CG Excise Act.
3. Argument heard.
4. Case of the prosecution, in brief is that on 12/03/2019, 6.120 bulk liters of foreign liquor has been seized from the possession of the applicant.
5. Counsel for the State submits that there is no antecedents of the applicant is reported in police case diary.
6. Looking to the above facts and circumstances of the case, the application is allowed. It is directed that if the applicant furnishes one solvent surety for a sum of Rs. 25,000/- along with one personal bond of Rs. 25,000/- to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned, she be released on bail.
