1. In view of the fact that the similar order as has been assailed in this petition was set aside by this Court in WPC No.1181/2018 (**J. K. Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research vs**

State of Chhattisgarh and others), decided on 27.04.2018, which was not interfered by the Supreme Court also in SLP (C) No.15925/2018 and in the said order of the Supreme Court, an earlier order in WPC No.532/2018 has also been referred, the present writ petition stands allowed to the said extent.
