Petitioners herein have preferred this Writ Petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the order dated 05/03/2019 passed in Claim MJC No. 03/2019 whereby the First Additional Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Korba has rejected the application filed by the petitioner for releasing the amount from fixed deposit.
