1. Heard. Admit. Case diary is available.
2. This is first bail application under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. preferred by the applicant before this Court and no other bail application is pending before any other Court.
3. The applicant has been arrested in connection with Crime No.65/2019 registered at Police Station D.D. Nagar, Raipur, District Raipur for the offence punishable under Section 20 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act.
4. Case of the prosecution, in brief is that on 25.02.2019 at about 15.50 hrs, Inspector Jitendra Verma, SHO, PS D.D. Nagar seized 2.650 kg cannabis from the joint possession of the applicant and co-accused Smt. Aarti Chhabda.
5. Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case, therefore, he may be released on bail.
6. On the other hand, counsel for the State opposes the bail application. He further submits that no criminal antecedent is reported against the applicant in police case diary.
7. Looking to the above facts and circumstances of the case, the bail application is allowed. It is directed that if the applicant furnishes one solvent surety for a sum of Rs.25,000/- along with a personal bond of Rs.25,000/- to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court, he be released on bail.
