1. The petitioner through this petition prays for a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide his representation (Annexure P/7) so far as his termination order is concerned.

According to counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has been acquitted by the Criminal Court vide judgment dated 01.10.2018 from the court of Judicial Magistrate First Class-Rajput, District Balrampur-Rajanujganj and therefore the department may reconsider the order of termination of the petitioner at this juncture.
