1. The grievance of the petitioner in the instant case is the non consideration of his claim for compassionate appointment.
2. Brief facts of the case is that, the father of the petitioner was working with the respondent No.2 and who died in harness on 17.03.2018. According to the petitioner, he had immediately moved an application on 16.04.2018 but though more than one year has lapsed no decision has been taken on the said application.
3. Given the aforesaid factual matrix of the case as narrated by the petitioner, this court is of the opinion that ends of justice would meet if a direction is given to the respondent No.2 to take a decision on the claim of the petitioner at the earliest preferably within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
4. The writ petition accordingly stands disposed of.
