Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been acquitted by the Jurisdictional Criminal Court in 19 to 20 matters but it has not been recorded in the register maintained in the Police Station- City Kotwali Ambikapur which may be directed to be registered in the said Police Station.
2. Learned State counsel submits that the Station House Officer of the Police Station will act in accordance with law.
